Please refer to your proposal for Establishment of new medical college at Nizamabad, Andhra Pradesh in the name and style of "Government Medical College, Nizamabad" by Government of Andhra Pradesh u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

In this connection, I am directed to convey the approval of the Board of Governors for establishment of a new medical college at Nizamabad, Andhra Pradesh in the name and style of "Government Medical College, Nizamabad" by Government of Andhra Pradesh with an annual intake of 100 (One Hundred) students with prospective effect i.e. from the academic year 2013-14 u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956, as amended.

This permission of the Board of Governors, Medical Council of India for establishment of new medical college and admission of students is initially for a period of one year. It will be renewed on yearly basis on verification of achievements of annual target set out in the project report. This process of annual renewal of permission will continue till such time the establishment of medical college and expansion of hospital facilities are completed as per the norms of Medical Council of India.

In addition to above, this is further to inform you that while making admissions of your college to MBBS course it shall be ensured that:

- (i) No admission is permitted beyond the sanctioned intake capacity;
- (ii) Selection of Students to the Medical College is in accordance with the requirements laid down in the Graduate Medical Education Regulations, 1997;
- (iii) The admission process for the academic year 2013-14 has to be completed in accordance with the time schedule indicated in the Graduate Medical Education Regulation, 1997, as amended. No admission is permitted beyond the cut-off date.
- (iv) Submission of Undertaking by the State Chief Secretary of the State of Andhra Pradesh along with the provisions of the budgetary allocation with time line.

It shall be incumbent upon the Medical College that the information relating to admissions should be submitted within a fortnight of closure of admissions to the Council. Any failure to submit the information within this time limit would be construed that the admissions in the College were not in accordance with the statutory requirements, thereby enabling the Council to proceed in accordance with law against the College.
